Q1 What do parents need to bring to kindergarten registration?

Birth Certificate
Proof of Residency
Immunization Records

Q2 What should parents expect at kindergarten registration?

Register for Kindergarten, Meet the Kindergarten Teachers, tour the school, meet the principal, eat dinner in the cafeteria, take a bus ride.

One week prior to start of school.

Q8 How will a parent find out their child's teacher and classroom information?

At Registration Days prior to the start of school. Typically two weeks before school starts. All students who are pre-registered will get a letter in the mail announcing the dates of registration days.

Q9 When should they expect this information?

Two weeks prior to school starting.

Q10 When is the first day of school?

Day after labor day each year.

Q11 What time does school start and end?

Start time: **8:35AM**

End time: **3:38PM**

Q12 Will there be an open house/orientation prior to the beginning of school.

Yes, typically the Wednesday evening before school starts.
